**Pentecost** – Next Sunday we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost, sometimes called the birthday of the Church. The reading from the Acts of the Apostles tells of the great gathering of people who were speaking in their Native language of the great works of God. Anyone who has a Native costume is welcome to wear it next Sunday. The Acts talk of the Holy Spirit coming to the disciples in the form of flames of fire. All of us are welcome to wear red next weekend in honor of the Holy Spirit.

**Mass Intention Dates Available** – St. Joseph Holy Family Parish has openings for those who wish to have masses offered for family members or loved ones, especially for week days. The suggested mass stipend offering is \$10. Please contact the parish office to schedule masses.

**Server Training** – There will be server training on June 9 after Mass with Fr. Ed. Anyone who has been through First Communion is welcome to join us for the training.

**Election/Selection** – This year we need to elect a trustee-treasurer and select members-at-large for the pastoral council. The new term will start July 1. There are nomination forms in your pews to nominate people you think would be interested in these positions. Please check with them first before you submit their names. The election for trustee will take place June 15-16. Anyone interested in serving on any other committees should contact the office. There is one position open on the cemetery and buildings and grounds committees. The worship and activities committees could also use more members.

**Busy Bags** – Church Time will not be held during the summer, but there are “Busy Bags” for younger children in the gathering space to use during Mass.

**VIRTUS** – If you plan on volunteering and/or working with children in the faith formation program or Vacation Bible School, the Green Bay Diocese mandates that you complete a VIRTUS (Protecting God’s Children) training session. This awareness session will be offered locally on Saturday, June 8, at 9:00 a.m., at SS. Mary & Hyacinth Parish in Antigo. Sue Brettingen will be the instructor. Preregistration is required, and if you plan on attending, log on to [www.virtus.org](http://www.virtus.org) and click “First Time Registrant” to begin. If you do not have online access but would like to sign up, please contact Diane at the parish office and she can register you in advance. If you have already completed this program, you do not have to do it again.

**All Saints Scholarships** – Our parish is again offering scholarships for students attending All Saints School next year. Applications are available in the gathering space and from the parish office and must be returned by July 19. The amount given will be determined by the number of applications received.
