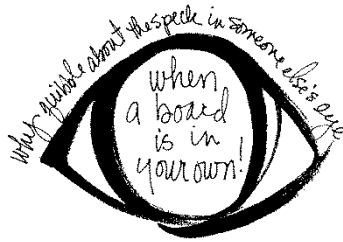

**Lent** – Lent begins this Wednesday, March 6. Our theme for Lent this year is “Renew Your Spirit,” based on a Lenten booklet by the same name. These booklets, along with the Little Black Books, are located in the gathering space. Near the booklets are a basket with metal crosses and a basket with square coins imprinted with three nails. When you pick up a booklet, please pick up a “cross of commitment” and hang it on a nail on the wooden cross. Take a three-nail coin to carry with you as a reminder of your personal Lent commitment to “Renew Your Spirit.” There are also Rice Bowls and prayer cards (Daily Prayers for an End to Hunger). Catholic Relief Services (CRS) was formed by the US bishops to help the foreign countries in every safe country in the world. They started the Rice Bowls to help the poor in many countries, especially the immigrants, and as a reminder for us to give to the poor as well. The paper in the folded box has recipes of foods from other countries and more about CRS. You may return the Rice Bowls during Holy Week or Easter.

#### Lenten Regulations:

- Catholics who have celebrated their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and each Friday of Lent.
- Catholics who have celebrated their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday, in addition to abstaining from meat, should fast (eat only one full meal) on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Small quantities of food may be taken at two other meals, but no food should be consumed at other times during those two days. The obligation of fasting ceases with the celebration of one’s 59<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- These practices are designed for spiritual growth. Catholics are not to excuse themselves lightly from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.
